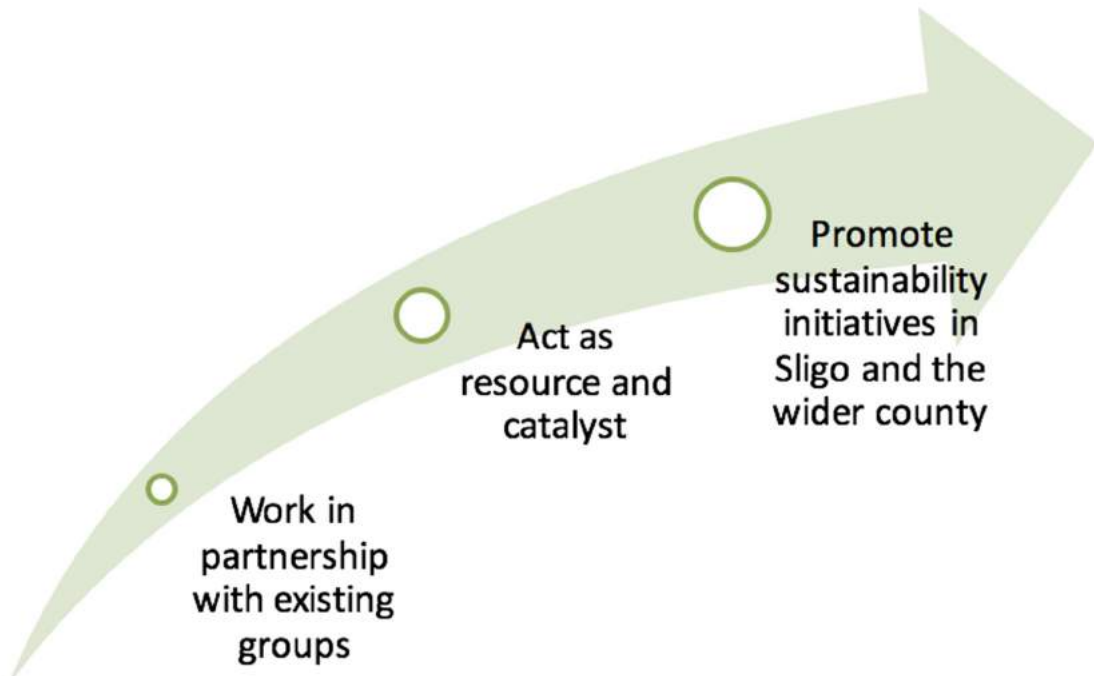

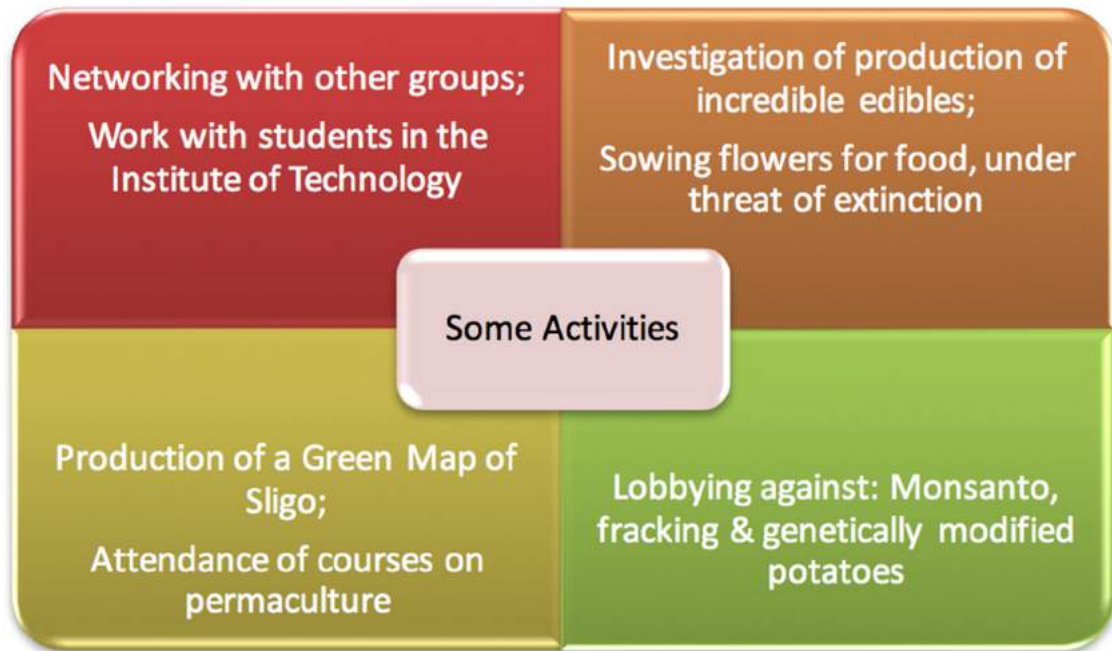


Transition Town Sligo
